

Can I use a power plug in Thailand?

Comments: *Some outlets are a combination of type A and C and can accept either type plug. Find out the power plug type for Thailand before you visit Chiang Mai so you can bring the proper socket adapters for your electrical devices. Check the voltage and frequency requirements for Thailand and pack a power converter if necessary.

Will my plugs fit in a Thai power outlet?

It means any device with the below plugs will fit in most Thai electrical outlets: You might need a voltage adapter for Thailand. Although your plugs can fit in most power outlets in Thailand, it is unlikely that the voltage is compatible with Thai electricity supply.

What voltage does Thailand use?

Unlike the U.S., and like most other countries - Thailand's electrical grid uses a frequency of 50 Hz and a voltage of 220V. What kind of power adapter do I need for Thailand? A common question most travelers ask is, "What plug do I need for Thailand?"

What is a Thai power outlet?
