Are battery electricity storage systems a good investment?

We use the units of \$/kWh because that is the most common way that battery system costs have been expressed in published material to date. The \$/kWh costs we report can be converted to \$/kW costs simply by multiplying by the duration (e.g.,a \$300/kWh,4-hour battery would have a power capacity cost of \$1200/kW).

How long does an energy storage system last?

The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment analyzed energy storage systems from 2 to 10 hours. The 2022 Cost and Performance Assessment analyzes storage system at additional 24- and 100-hour durations.

The best way to understand and compare estimates between different installers is to determine how much your solar panel system will cost per watt (\$/W).
